Nursing in Japan - Fun Facts

- ❖ You don't have to renew your license in Japan. Once an RN, you're one for life!
- ❖ 1 in every 23 Japanese nurses works more than 60 hours of overtime per month
- ❖ Japan recognizes four types of nurses: Public Health Nurses, Midwives, Registered Nurses and Assistant Nurses
- ❖ Japan's exam for foreign nurses is so difficult that between 2009 and 2015, only 96 out of 741 nurses who took the test passed

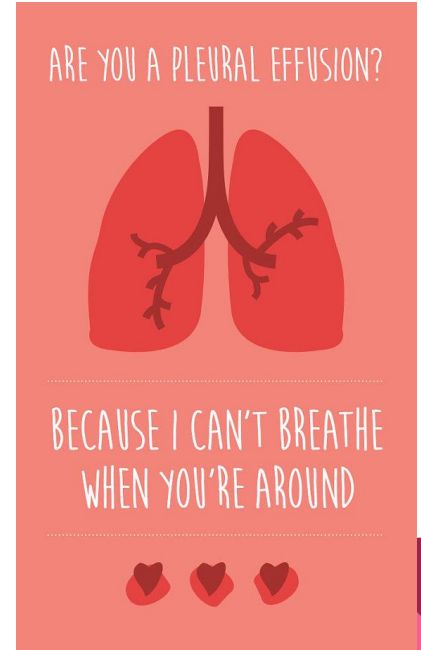
