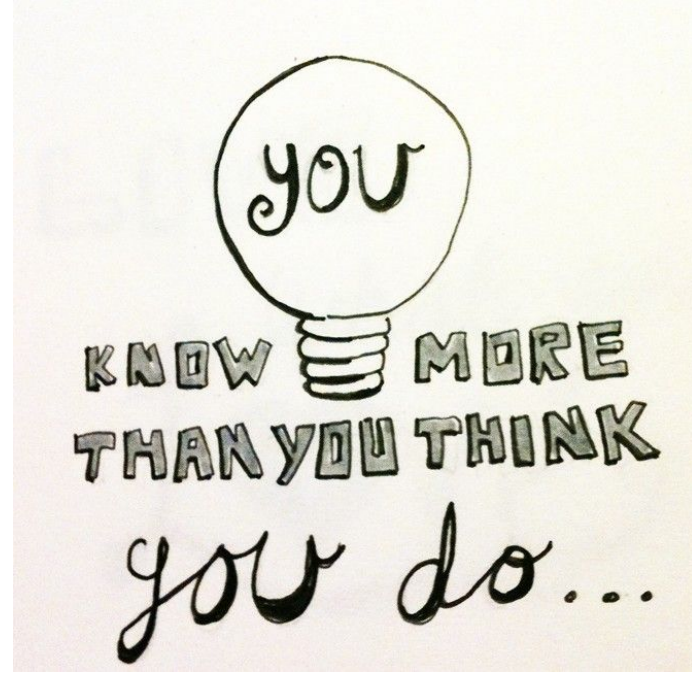

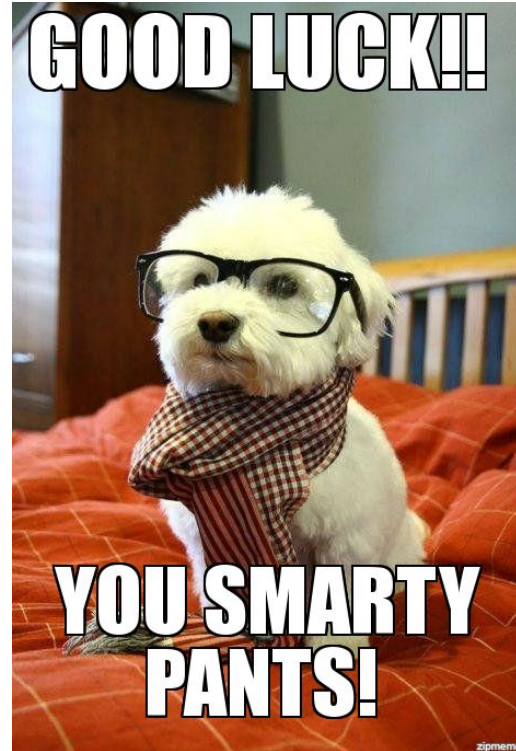

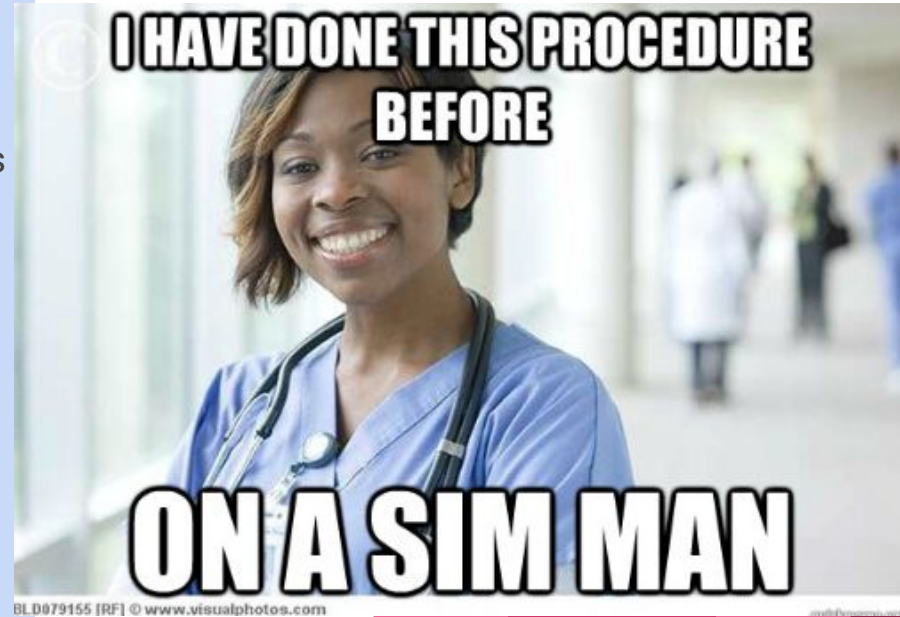

- ❖ Approval of cord points along with the President and Vice president



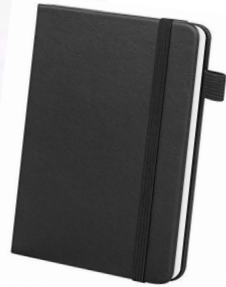
